

BUILDING USE GUIDELINES

FOR PHASE 1 REOPENING FROM COVID-19 QUARANTINE

On Monday, June 1, Governor Brown's COVID-19 Task Force granted permission for organizations located in Washington County to enter Phase 1 for "reopening for business." Therefore, we are now opening our church building for group meetings under the following guidelines. Please note that **sanitization is critical** to our church because of many at-risk individuals in our congregation:

1. Group sizes must be limited to 25 or less. **No exceptions.**
2. Social distancing of a minimum of 6 feet must be observed. **No exceptions.**
3. Masks are recommended, though not required.
4. Only use the room that is designated for meeting.
5. Clean restroom surfaces, including faucet and sink.
6. Clean/disinfect toilets and urinals.
7. Sanitize restroom paper towel and soap dispensers.
8. Clean/disinfect water fountains.
9. Sanitize all surfaces in the meeting room.
10. Sanitize doorknobs, light switches, handrails, etc.

Please note that each organization is expected to bring their own cleaning and disinfecting supplies. If, in the event that one or more of the above requirements were not adhered to, we will close the church building until further notice.
