

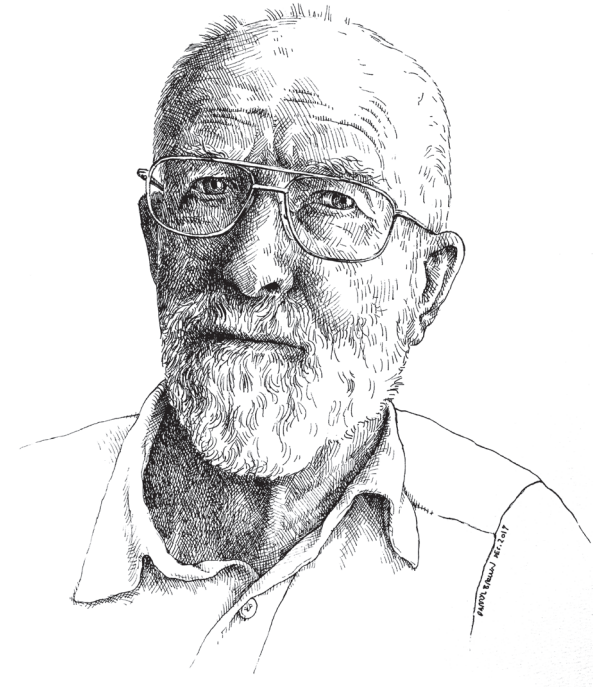

Celebrating the life of
RANDALL BROWN

Dec. 6, 1925 – June 1, 2019

RANDALL BROWN passed away peacefully on Saturday, June 1, 2019 at Friendsview Retirement Community. He was 93 years old.

Randall was the son of Quaker missionaries and spent his high school years on the mission field in Burundi, Africa. After returning to the U.S. for college, he married Sara Owens and they returned to Burundi. 12 years later, Randall, Sara and their three boys were deported from Burundi due to civil unrest. Randall completed his PhD in Corvallis and became a biology professor. He taught at a women's college in Iran, as well as at colleges in Birmingham, Alabama and Huntington, Indiana. He and Sara retired to Newberg where he taught some courses at George Fox University. They were active members at Sherwood Community Friends Church as well as with Volunteers on Wheels and later in their community at Friendsview.

Randall will be remembered as a wonderful teacher, husband, father and friend. He'll be remembered for his love, kindness, patience and dry sense of humor. He lived a life of service to God and neighbor.

Randall is preceded in death by his wife Sara and son Mark. He is survived by sons Clayton and Darryl and numerous grand- and great-grandchildren. He will be missed.
